



Publication Charge Policy

Journal of the College of Education for Women is an open access journal; therefore, no subscription fees are required. The journal charges each single manuscript ONLY after being accepted. The Publication fees are determined as follows:

Researchers from outside Iraq are charged one hundred and fifty American Dollars, (**\$150**) to support the publishing service code, including the fees of the similarity index scanning, which amounts to fifteen thousand Iraqi dinars.

Researchers from inside Iraq are charged one hundred and fifty thousand Iraqi Dinars (**150ID**), including the fees of the similarity index scanning, which amounts to fifteen thousand Iraqi dinars (**15,000ID**).

The Journal's Waiver Policy Statement

- No fees are required for developing countries with low income countries according to the World Bank Country classification by Income level.
- No Fees are required for the best three research papers written by researchers residing outside Iraq.
- No fees are required from researchers who submit originality-based papers.

Method of Payment for the Locals

- The fees are paid in cash to the college journal accountant personally, once you receive an e-mail notification from the journal official email address (jcoeduw@coeduw.uobaghdad.edu.iq) by the managing editor. The accountant office is located on the third floor of the Administration building inside the College of Education for Women- University of Baghdad- Al-Jadiriya Campus.
- Once the researcher receives the receipts, s/he must hand the receipts to the secretary of the journal, and keep a copy of them with him/her. Only then, the researcher has the right to receive a hard copy of the research paper acceptance letter.
- If the researcher made the payment and could not hand the original copies to the secretary for any reason, s/he must send an electronic copy of the receipts to the managing editor through the journal official email address (jcoeduw@coeduw.uobaghdad.edu.iq) to receive an electronic acceptance letter.
